It is with pleasure that I write my first President's Report to the Annual General Meeting.

The year has flown past, and I can't believe that we are heading into Christmas yet again!

As I review the year, the first project undertaken on the list was the creation of an external toilet that all members could use. This was achieved very easily, it caused no damage to the club house and the cost was minimal. In fact it looks like it was always there! I know members were very pleased to finally have this facility. Thank you very much to Zoe Warrell - (a new member at the time), who did a great job prepping and painting the door and frame. We are happy you joined our club Zoe!

On 20th April our defibrillator was installed and it has been mounted to the wall in the external toilet. We had 13 members attend a training session conducted by an instructor from St. John Ambulance. Kim, the instructor, delivered a very informative talk. The unit is designed for simple and reliable operation by minimally trained users whereby you follow the voice instructions for each step in using the defibrillator. We are fortunate to have this piece of equipment located on our grounds.

We were very pleased to see the transformation of the old orange trailer that once sat in the shed, into the very useful grey dressage trailer it has become. It houses all four arenas together with 48 markers. It has made the task of setting up for our dressage jackpot and, indeed, the packing up too, a much easier task.

The grounds have been regularly mowed and whipper snipped and Di has done a superb job in keeping our gardens looking beautiful. Thank you Di for the many hours you spend weeding, planting, mulching, buying plants and keeping them alive. It doesn't go unnoticed!

On that note, I would like to mention our grounds and the work that has been undertaken by members. Every fence was in a state of disrepair at the beginning of the year and I am happy to report that all fences are now back in great shape. Various members have removed dead trees that have fallen across the fences causing the disrepair to begin with, then rejoined wires and restrained the fences. Thank you very much to those members, particularly Sandy and Mark Cornell, Jen and Laz Rao and Lloyd Walker.

Our working bees have been very well attended. So much was achieved and it was great to see members from both pony club and adult riders working together for the benefit of all. I believe that a collaborative effort is a great way of building on the harmonious relationship that exists between the two clubs today.

We provided a BBQ and some drinks towards the end of the work and this was enjoyed and appreciated by the members and it gave people an opportunity to meet and have a chat with someone that they had not met before. Thank you Di for getting the barbie going!

One of my goals is to improve our facilities and grounds for members and I know that some headway was made this year in that direction. Pony Club funded quite a few new cross country jumps and repairs to existing dilapidated ones and we are grateful to them for that.

The committee revisited the dust problem that exists on our arenas during the summer months and much investigation and discussion took place. There really is only one way to solve this issue and it is an irrigation system. This is a costly project - we do have a quote from a business that is experienced in providing irrigation to large areas. The quote is \$35K. There is considerable irrigation infrastructure required along with water storage, pump and appropriate automated sprinkler systems to do the job properly. We don't have a solution in the short term, however it remains an issue that we are keen to resolve.

Towards the latter part of the year, Cath Giles, who is our Council Liaison Officer, also kindly agreed to represent HDARC on the Equine Industry and Activity Strategy Reference Group.

We are lucky to have Cath take responsibility for these roles on behalf of our club and we thank her very much for doing so. Also thank you Cath for being our trail riding extraordinaire. We are grateful for the time that you spend in organising these activities for our members.

We saw a handing over of the reins from Sarah Walsh to Hayley Harrington as coordinator of Jenny Sheppard lessons. We thank Sarah for all that she has done over the past years. It is a big job organizing people on a regular basis and I know that our members and also people outside of the club, who regularly attend Jenny's lessons, are very thankful to Sarah for her commitment. Thank you very much to Hayley for taking over from Sarah, you are doing a fabulous job!

It is pleasing to report that both Wednesday and Saturday rallies were very well attended this year and our arenas held up well - I think we only had to cancel one Wednesday rally due to a deluge of rain the previous night.
